



## KINDERGARTEN

### Supplies

- 2 boxes of kleenex
- 1 complete change of clothes to be left at school
- 1 pair non-skid, non-marking indoor shoes
- 1 box of ziploc bags (any size)
- Headphones (to use with Chromebook) in a Ziploc and labelled with name
- 1 paint shirt
- Lunch kit
- Large backpack
- Water bottle for use at school
- 1 package plastic spoons and forks



# GRADE ONE and TWO

## Supplies

- Scissors – good quality
- 20 Pencils HB – good quality
- Pencil sharpener with lid
- 5 Erasers – gum or white are best
- 2 Packs of 24 or 36 wax crayons (not the big packs)
- 1 Pack of pencil crayons
- 1 Pack of markers
- 2 Pencil boxes (preferred) or pencil cases
- Metric ruler – 30cm (0-30 CM NOT MM)
- 5 Glue sticks (large size or 8 small ones)
- 1 bottle white glue
- 1 ½ plain/ ½ INTERLINED exercise book (half of the page is blank for pictures)
- 2 Boxes of Kleenex (150's) – for classroom use
- 1 Pocket folder – to be kept in backpack for transporting reading sheets and homework
- 1 Large binder – to be kept at home to store worksheets from our reading program
- 1 box of ziplocs (any size)
- INDOOR RUNNERS – Please make sure the soles are not black – NON-MARRING ONLY
- Headphones (in Ziploc with name on them) for computers & Daily 5
- 1 Complete change of season-appropriate clothes
- 1 Paint shirt
- 1 package plastic spoons or forks

\* Please make sure your child's name is on EVERY school supply to avoid being lost or confused with another student's supplies.



# Grade Three/Four - Mrs. Sandra Bjornson

## Supplies

- Indoor Non-Marring Shoes for P.E (white soled shoes can still mark the floor, please test in the store)
- 24 min. sharpened HB Pencils, **PLEASE label: name/initials** on **each pencil** with a Sharpie
- 1 package of Pencil Crayons (sharpened, please 🍷) and 2 packages of Markers (broad or wide-tipped markers are preferable)
- 3 large glue sticks and 2 small bottles of White Glue
- 1 pair of semi-sharp school scissors (medium length blade is best)
- 1-2 Pencil Boxes/Cases (large enough to fit all supplies with the exception of extra pencils and a ruler)
- 4-6 Erasers ( **Please label**)
- 1 30 **30-centimetre** ruler (preferably not bendable)
- 1-2 Pencil Sharpeners with lids
- One Highlighter
- One Black Sharpie-labelled
- 1 (60-80 page) Notebook for a LA (**26.7 cm x 20.3 cm/10.5 in x 8 in**) \*PLEASE ENSURE NOTEBOOKS HAVE **MARGINS\***
- 1 Math Notebook (**pages are graph paper**). IF these are unavailable, purchase the same as listed above
- 2 Pocket Folders, one for Science and one for Social
- 1 Clipboard for various adventures
- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- Inexpensive Headphones/Earbuds (in a labelled ziploc)
- silverware to donate, spoons/forks/butterknife,s as we'll be washing daily (no more than 5 pieces of each necessary)
- water bottle with a pop-top/easy closure lid, otherwise we have spills
- Protractor (half circle measure)

**Please LABEL as many supplies as possible** with your child's name, as well as **outdoor BOOTS/SHOES, mittens, toques/hats**, to help avoid being lost or confused with another student's items

PUT IN PENCIL BOXES 1 or 2 pencils and eraser, one glue stick, one bottle of glue, the extras can go in a ziploc and be stored in their lockers.



## GRADE Five/Six - Mrs. Alison Bjornson

### Supplies

- 5 binders (1 inch thick) - labeled Math, Language, Science, Social
- 1 package of loose leaf paper (not in binder)
- 2 pens of various colours
- 6 pack of dry erase markers (labeled with name)
- 2 highlighters
- 3 black Sharpie markers
- 1 large glue stick or 1 white glue bottle
- 6 white erasers or pencil topper/cap replacement erasers
- 1 package of pencil crayons (24)
- 1 package of markers (12)
- 48 pencils (Please buy quality pencils as the cheaper pencils do not last)
- 1 pencil sharpener with lid
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 ruler (30 cm)
- 1 pair of scissors
- Pencil case or box to fit supplies
- 1 pair gym runners with non-marking soles
- Gym change (t-shirts, shorts, or sweats)
- 1 set of inexpensive headphones to use at school with their chrome books (labelled)
- 1 mouse (optional for chrome books) (labelled)
- Pack of disposable spoons and forks and/or old metal cutlery that we can keep and wash in class
- 1 clipboard (labelled)
- Protractor (half circle measure)

Please label with Sharpie or similar label.

If parents wish to keep some supplies at home for later on in the school year that would be great or supply a small container to keep extra supplies in student lockers.

## Supplies

- Scientific calculator (Grade 9)
- Simple 4 Function calculator (Grades 7-8)
- Large eraser
- Metric ruler (30 cm, non-folding)
- Colored pencil crayons
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Indoor (non-marking) shoes- this is for all students but especially for Gr. 10-12 who have classes in the VEP room because of the carpet.
- Gym Change: T-shirt, shorts or sweats
- Box of Kleenex to keep in their locker
