

School EAL Summary Sheet

Any English as an Additional Language (EAL) student should be assessed using the Alberta K-12 English as an Additional Language Proficiency Benchmarks (Benchmarks 2.0) starting in their Grade One year. Any student registered in a Pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten level only receives half of the funding and funding is only available for the first five years subsequent to being assessed with the Benchmarks. Students new to the division should be assessed in the Fall (September) and Spring (May) of their first year. After the first year, the May assessment may be used as their Fall assessment for the next school year, resulting in students only needing to be assessed once per year, after their first year.

Please note when completing this form, the EAL Code **303** is for **Canadian-born students** and the EAL Code **301** is for **Foreign-born students**.
